




How to get your idea to the clinic

- Before anything else, make sure you are not the only one interested in your idea, and that someone else is not already doing it
- Be sure you have strong preliminary data/rationale—engage basic and translational scientists!
- Be sure your idea makes sense
- Figure out how many patients are needed/how many are possible—find a statistician partner!







What are the mechanisms to get your trial funded?

- Company sponsored IIT (easiest)
- Company sponsored IIT with only drug provided (hardest)
- Phase 1/2—ETCTN
- Phase 2/3 -- NCTN



What if you only have drug?

- Institutional funding
- Discuss with company opportunities for funding remainder based on results from pilot
- LLS (academic clinical trials program), LRF (correlative funding), NCI



Finding Prospective Grants

- Grant mechanisms to consider as fellows/junior faculty
 - ASCO YIA or CDA
 - ASH scholar
 - LLS clinical scholar award
 - ACS clinical scientist development grant
 - LRF clinical investigator career development award
 - K08
 - R50
 - Other disease specific foundations



Finding Prospective Grants

- Make a list of deadlines, including institutional deadlines
- Figure out how different the requirements are (what you can reuse)
- Apply to everything you are eligible for
- Have as many people as possible look at your grants





Finding Prospective Grants

- Make a list of deadlines

- Engage your mentors for advice
- Developing clinical trials and writing grants becomes easier the more times you do them
- Never work in a vacuum
